




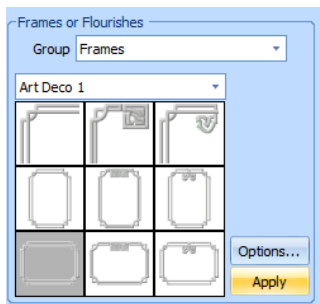


## HUSQVARNA VIKING® 5D™ Embroidery

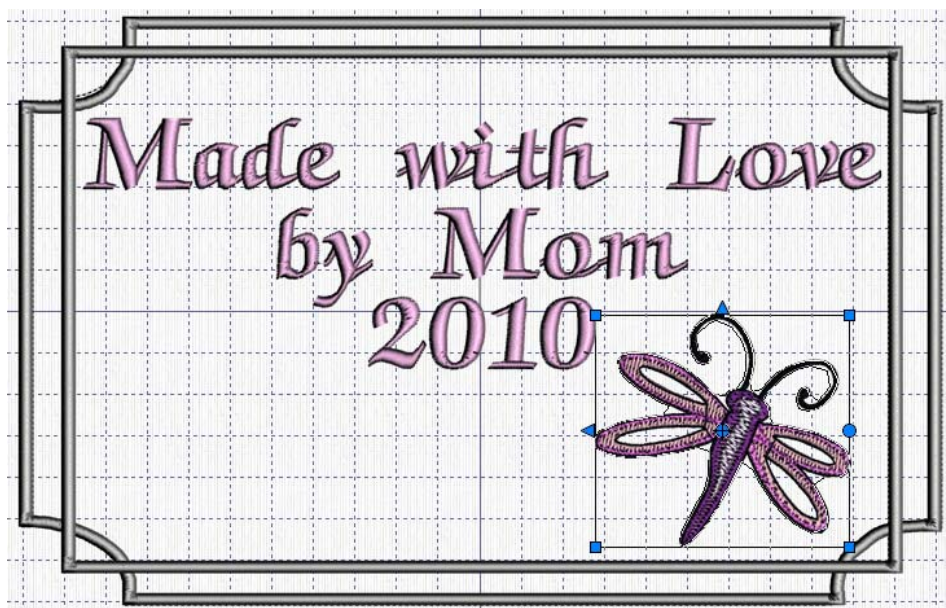
### Tag for a Quilt.




When you have finished a quilt or a memorable sewing project for your child or friend, add a tag as that will make it feel even more personal. In 5D™ Embroidery or 5D™ Embroidery Extra you have a lot of options. There are over 700 frames and flourishes to choose from which fit your design or lettering automatically. Other new features such as viewing fonts as you step through their names, and Duplicate are also shown in this quilt label.

1. Open the 5D Embroidery  or 5D Embroidery Extra .
2. Click on Hoop .
3. In the Hoop Group, select the HUSQVARNA VIKING® Designer Diamond and in the Hoop size select the Large Hoop 240 x 150mm.
4. Set the Orientation to Horizontal, and click OK.
5. Click on Preferences . The grid size should be set to 10mm and the Remove Overlap and the Spell Check should be checked, with the language set for EnglishUS.
6. Click on the Letter tab.
7. Click on the drop down arrow by the Categories.
8. Select the Category: Script.
9. Click on the down arrow to the right side by the Font name Adina 12-40mm, and use the arrow keys on your computer to step down and see the selection available in this category.
10. Select the font: Calligraph 15- 50 mm.
11. Type in the letters box: “Made with Love”. Hold down the Ctrl key and click Enter at the same time to create another line. Type “by Mom”. Click Ctrl and Enter to create another line. Type “2010”.
12. The Line Type should be set as the Horizontal Line. Click Apply
13. Right-click on the text in the work area, and the Letter Properties will be displayed.
14. For the Alignment choose Center Alignment and increase the size of the letters to 17mm. Click OK.
15. Click on the Design tab.
16. Click ColorSort  and the number of colors are reduced to one. Click on the blue color in the Color Selection box and change it to Robison-Anton Rayon 40, # 2502 Memphis Belle. Click OK.
17. Click on the Frame tab.
18. Click on the down arrow to display the Group selections.
19. Select Frames, then select Art Deco 1 from the lower list. Click the frame in Row 1, Column 3 (a tooltip will appear showing it is number 7). Make sure the text is still selected and has got a selection box around it; otherwise click on the text to select it again.



20. Click Apply. The Frame will be created at a size to fit around the text.
21. The height of the Frame is a bit too big for the hoop. Click on the Edit tab while the frame is still selected.
22. Click on Make Block From Visible Area
23. Change the Height to 85%. Click Apply.
24. Click on the Design Tab.
25. Click on Center in Hoop
26. Select the text by clicking on it (Use the Tab key to move between embroideries).  
Click and drag to move the text to the upper area of the Frame.
27. Nudge the text by using the arrow keys on your computer.
28. Click on the View Designs (camera) icon
29. Browse to the folder:  
Documents\5DEmbroidery\Samples\5DEmb\Stitch2\Butterflies and Bugs and click OK. (For Windows® XP the samples are in a subfolder of MyDocuments.)
30. Click on the down arrow, and Select the Perky Dragonfly. Close the Viewer.
31. Move the dragonfly to the lower right corner of the hoop.
32. Click in the Color Selection area on the first green color; change it to Robison-Anton Rayon 40, # 2501 Petal Pink.
33. Change the second green color to Robison-Anton Metallic J 40 # 1011, Pink.



34. Click on Duplicate , and a second dragonfly will appear on the work area. Move it to the lower left corner.
35. Click on the mirror handle on the left side of the second Dragonfly to flip it horizontally.
36. While the second dragonfly is still selected, click on Resize  so the embroidery will be resized with an adjustment in stitch density.
37. Hold down the Ctrl key and click and drag one of the corners of the design until the selection box is approximately one grid square bigger. If the design is touching the lettering, move it slightly.
38. Click on Combine All .
39. Save the embroidery in your computer, then click on Send 1 to the USB stick or your embroidery machine.
