

## Husqvarna Viking DESIGNER DIAMOND™ Gems of Wisdom



### Majestic Hoop

- When using the Majestic Hoop (#920 222 096), be sure to use the 16 hoop clips that come with the hoop. Because of the size of the hoop, the hoop clips will keep the fabric taut in the hoop, and insure a great stitch out! Because the hoop clips hold the stabilizer tight to the hoop, it is easy to get it caught in the Embroidery Hoop Attachment clip on the embroidery arm as you are sliding the hoop onto the embroidery arm. To prevent this from happening, trim the stabilizer close to the hoop where it attaches to the embroidery arm and keep the fabric up and out of the way as you slide on the hoop.
- Be sure to open both Quick Release levers on your Majestic Hoop. Loosen the screws equally, and insert your fabric and stabilizer. Then be sure that both Quick Release Screws are equally tight and closed. If you hoop the fabric and only tighten one of the sides, it puts uneven tension on the fabric on one side and can cause fabric distortion resulting in poor embroidery results.
- To remove the hoop clips, push the embroidery unit release button to remove the hoop from the embroidery arm. Open the Quick Release levers. Turn the hoop upside down on a table. Push out the inner hoop. Many of the clips will fall on to the table, the remaining ones will be easy to remove!
- If you feel that your **DESIGNER DIAMOND™** is stitching slower on the large Majestic Hoop designs, you are correct! The speed of all the embroidery on the **DESIGNER DIAMOND™** is computer controlled for the best embroidery stitch out quality. It stitches slower on the large designs because it is “moving” more hoop area in the larger hoop.
- In order for the design to be split for the **DESIGNER DIAMOND™** Majestic Hoop you must click Combine in 4D Software with the Majestic Hoop chosen.
- In order for the alignment stitches to be added to a Majestic Hoop design:
  1. Go to Preferences, and check “Alignment stitches for turnable hoop”
  2. Select the Majestic Hoop
  3. Click Combine to split the design
  4. Then use the SEND features to either send it to the USB embroidery stick or your Designer Diamond.
